AP Biology vs. Honors Biology Expectations Form 2022 - 23

Tesla STEM High School offers **two options** for students to complete their biology graduation

requirement in the 10th grade: AP or Honors. In the past, students have mistakenly believed that their 9th grade experience with AP Computer Science Principles (an introductory course) is comparable to the rigors of AP Biology. This is *not* the case: new content is introduced in AP Biology every single day. Going far beyond memorization, AP Biology requires students to constantly problem-solve based on thorough comprehension of the material and application of complex concepts. More than any other course, we have found that success in AP Biology is highly dependent on a student's ability to articulate their purpose and self-motivation for taking the AP version.

Please carefully read through the following and consider which option sounds most like you or your student:

AP BIOLOGY

Excellent reasons to register for AP Biology:

- I **love** biology. I am excited to immerse myself in **college-level** readings, lab work and reports, and a **fast-paced** testing schedule.
- I am highly **self-motivated** and have a handle on my **time-management**; thus, I can commit **at least one hour of homework per night** for this class alone, **not including additional study time** for labs and tests.
- I am purposefully seeking maximum rigor in biology & I have time in my schedule to do well in it.
- I am prepared to complete the required 25 to 30-hour-long summer assignment.
- I am seeking college credit; this is only earned through AP by scoring a 4-5/5 on the AP Exam in the spring.
- I'm seriously considering a career that requires a strong background in biology.

Not-so-excellent reasons to register for AP Biology:

- It will look good on my transcript, although I'm not very interested in biology and/or I am hoping to take other rigorous courses this year that better fit my academic plan (e.g. AP Computer Science A, Engineering, etc.)
- All my friends are taking it!
- I'm feeling pressured.

HONORS BIOLOGY (Now offers option to earn college credit!)

Excellent reasons to register for Honors Biology:

- I want a **rigorous biology course** with a recognized honors designation.
- I'm up for challenging coursework and substantial homework, but biology is not my primary focus, and I would prefer to have more time to focus on other classes and/or my extracurricular commitments.
- I am seeking **college credit**; this may be earned via the Honors Biology **dual-enrollment** option (Bellevue College, BIO 160) and is based on several assessments and assignments throughout the year rather than one cumulative test.
