Senior Graduation & College App Updates:

- ◆ If you have not already had your Senior meeting with your Counselor, please do this soon! Meeting with your Counselor and submitting your Senior College Packet is a mandatory component of your High School & Beyond Plan (a state graduation requirement). Those of you who need a Counselor Letter of Recommendation must meet with your Counselor to submit/review your Senior Packet a minimum of 3 weeks prior to your application deadline.
- ◆ Please remember to write your Counselor's name and email on college applications if your colleges are part of the Common App, or if they specify that they would like transcripts or documents sent electronically from your high school (eg. transcript, school report, school profile, recommendations). Make sure to do this at least 2 weeks prior to needing to "submit" any electronic applications, as Counselors do not have access to upload any information (GPA, recommendation letter, etc) until you provide your Counselor's email in your application.
- ◆ For paper (snail mail) transcript requests, please complete and return a Transcript Request Form at our Main Office. You will need to allow 3 school days to process your request.
- ◆ Ms Wescott was in 12th grade English classes on Sept 12th, discussing seniors' graduation requirements as well as organizing the starting pieces of college applications. A copy of the PPT is located on the Counseling Powerschool page under College & Career Info -> College Application Tutorials and Senior Tips. This is a new section of our Counseling Powerschool page, also including college application tips and info on accessing dual credit grades/transcripts.

Financial Aid

- ◆ On September 18th, 2017, STEM hosted a College Financing presentation by Seattle University. Those of you who were not able to attend the presentation can view the PPT on our Powerschool page -> Financial Aid Resources (look on the Right tab).
- ◆ Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) forms and the CSS profile (used by some private colleges for Merit Aid) should be completed within the next two months (or sooner if necessary for any of your colleges' scholarship opportunities!). Please refer to our Counseling Powerschool page -> Financial Aid Resources for the FAFSA website, helpful guides, and clear steps for FAFSA completion.

PE waiver via the Fitness Assessment or Written Fitness Plan:

Many of our students will be opting to meet LWSD's PE/Fitness graduation requirement through the Fitness Assessment or Written Fitness Plan. This option is available during 11th and 12th grades only. Assessment/submission dates this year are Nov 29th, 2017 and February 28th, 2018. *(please note the district moved back these dates by 1-2 weeks to allow more time for completion)*
